### Dr. BeeJ's Court: Calling Out or Fault on Yourself



From time to time we may need to clarify some rule confusion and we'll use Judge BeeJ to help us to resolve the issue.

Court Etiquette: Good sportsmanship should always be a priority especially in league and tournament play. You may call a fault or out on yourself even if your opponent calls your shot in your favor. If you know that it was a fault or an out, then it is

permissible for you to overturn the call even though it will cost you the serve or point. You may even overturn a line judge if you know your own ball was out. Following is the rule from the rule book:

6.D.13. Players may call faults on themselves or line calls to their disadvantage during or after the completion of a rally. This includes overriding a line judge's call if it is to their disadvantage.
